How Do WE Recognize Jesus?

Today's reading shows us how John the Baptist answered the question in the title of today's column. He was walking the day after the baptism experience and saw Jesus coming toward him. He said to his disciples, "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world. He is the one of whom I said, 'A man is coming after me who ranks ahead of me because he existed before me.'" Remember that this reading is in John's Gospel which begins with the sentence "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." John the Baptist had recognized who Jesus was and recognized his own identity in relation to the identity of Jesus. John speaks clearly of *WHY* he baptized Jesus: "I have seen and can testify that He is the Son of God."

How do we apply this to our own lives?

Perhaps the first challenge is to discover the depth to which I wish to testify that Jesus IS the Son of God. Unless I am conscious of this question and the implications of answering it, I may well miss the point of John's explanation about who Jesus is.

John refers to Jesus as the "Lamb of God," The role of the lamb in Jewish worship was that of the sacrifice ritual. Jesus is thus identified as God's sacrificial lamb. He is offered as reparation for the sins of the world. He alone can fulfill this role. This will only make sense when we realize what the Incarnation was about and how it is connected to the Paschal Mystery. He came among us as the sinless one to become one with us and thus in his human identity to be able to redeem us! It wasn't just a matter of showing up and dying for us. It was a matter of living a life which models for us what it means to be a person whose love is so great that laying down his life for the world was the goal of his life. He loved us enough to want us to have what only God could give us: eternal life. If that meant his death and resurrection, so be it!

As we enter into this season of ordinary time, we will be hearing the Gospel of Matthew on Sundays. We will be challenged to see Jesus as Matthew chooses to portray him: the New Moses, the new Lawgiver, and the new Teacher. After the resurrection, when Jesus appears to his disciples and others they do not recognize him even though his greeting is "Peace." They had spent months with him and they had completely recognized him. So there is hope for me as I struggle to recognize Him in human form. Perhaps He will not look like a member of the family, but He is! He may come to me as the person in the store, the neighbor next door, a person on the street or in any other human form. Will I see through the disguise by faith, or will I go on missing His entrance into that present moment? This is our challenge for the week.

Reconocer a Jesús?

La lectura de hoy nos muestra como Juan el Bautista responde a la pregunta del título de esta columna. Juan, se encontraba caminando un día después de la experiencia con el bautizo y de pronto vio a Jesús aproximándose a él. Juan dijo entonces a los discípulos: "He aquí el cordero de Dios que quita el pecado del mundo. El es aquel del que yo dije: 'El que viene después de mí me ha precedido, porque existía antes que yo.'" Recordemos que este pasaje lo encontramos en el Evangelio de San Juan el cual comienza con esta oración: "Al principio existía la Palabra, y la Palabra estaba con Dios, y la Palabra era Dios." Juan el Bautista había reconocido quien era Jesús y reconoció que su propia identidad estaba ligada a la identidad de Jesús. Juan aclara el POR QUE bautizo a Jesús: "Yo lo he visto y doy testimonio de que El es el Hijo de Dios."

¿Cómo aplicamos esto a nuestras propias vidas?

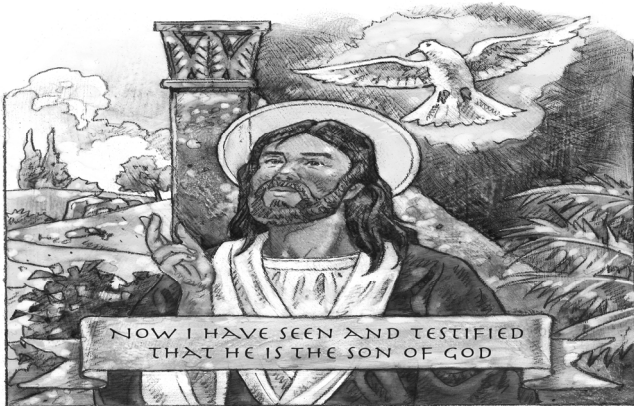
Tal vez el primer reto está en descubrir la intensidad con la cual quiero testificar que Jesús ES el Hijo de Dios. A menos que yo este consciente sobre la pregunta y lo que esto implica contestarla, sino podría perder el punto de la explicación de Juan sobre quien es Jesús.

Juan se refiere a Jesús como el "Cordero de Dios." El rol de un cordero en el culto Judío era convertirse en el sacrificio del ritual. Jesús es pues identificado como el cordero sacrificado de Dios. El es ofrecido como sacrificio para la reparación de los pecados del mundo. Jesús, por si solo puede satisfacer este rol. Todo esto nos hace sentido hasta que comprendemos el por qué de la Encarnación y como esta está ligada al Misterio de la Pascua. ¡Jesús vino al mundo sin mancha alguna para convertirse en uno de nosotros y por lo tanto en identidad humana para así podernos redimir! Esto no fue cuestión de solo demostrar que murió por nosotros. Esta fue cuestión de vivir una Vida que nos modela el significado de ser una persona la cual su amor es tan grande que su única meta en esta vida fue extender su vida al mundo entero. Nos amó tanto que nos quiso dar lo que solo Dios podía darnos: La Vida Eterna. ¡Aunque esto implicara su muerte y resurrección!

Mientras damos inicio a esta etapa del tiempo ordinario, estaremos escuchando el Evangelio de San Mateo. Tendremos el reto de ver a Jesús tal como San Mateo lo presenta: el Nuevo Moisés, el nuevo Legislador y el nuevo Maestro. Cuando Jesús se les aparece a sus apóstoles y a otros después de su resurrección, ellos no lo reconocen aun cuando su saludo fue "Paz." Ellos convivieron meses con El y debieron haberlo reconocido completamente. Por lo tanto hay una esperanza para mí cuando se me dificulta reconocer a Jesús en forma humana. Tal vez no parecerá como un miembro de mi familia, ¡Pero lo es! Puede ser que vendrá a mí como una persona en el mercado, como vecino de al lado, una persona en la calle o en cualquier forma humana. ¿Voy a verlo a través del disfraz por la Fe, ó seguiré de largo y perderé su entrada en ese preciso momento? Este es nuestro reto para la semana.
